



EITC (Educational Improvement Tax Credit) is a financial aid program that earmarks PA tax credits to help families afford tuition. Some of our families have received monies from this program.

In the 2009-2010 budget, this program was cut by \$25 million. Governor Rendell has issued a 2010-2011 budget that cuts this program by an additional \$10 million even though public education funding is being increased!

Operation Restore is a campaign to restore funding for Pennsylvania's EITC Program. The goal for this campaign is to demonstrate overwhelming parent, school, business and community support to restore funding for the EITC Program.
