

The minimum participation for the 2009-2010 school year in the BC Bucks Program is \$4200. In order to receive the tuition credits at the end of the year, this goal MUST be reached.

If you have reached your \$4200 commitment, you will receive your tuition credit off your final tuition payment. To see how much tuition credit you have received for the first half of the school year (June 2009 through the end of December 2009); you can check your online GL Scrip Account.

To Do:

- Login using the ID & Password sent to you in November.
- Click on Account Activity
- Look at the “Rebate Distributed” section of this page to see the total amount earned so far.
  - You will also see those families that are contributing on your behalf.
- Look at the “Rebate Not Yet Distributed” and divide this rebate in ½ to see where you are this quarter.
  - This section does not include those families contributing on your behalf. They can see that by logging on to their own account.

Update Profile:

- Pick-Up Method: How you would like to receive your BC Bucks. That way anytime you order online- we'll know how to get them to you.
- EMail Address: We can alert you when the next Distribution is run to see your updated Tuition Credits.

Sign-Up for PrestoPay:

- Presto-Pay™ is a convenient way for your family to pay your organization online at the time you place your order. GLSC will automatically debit your checking account for the face value amount of your order, plus a small convenience fee of \$0.39, and hold that payment until your non-profit's order has been released by your coordinator.

Place an Order:

- Did you know that you can also place your “Immediate Fill” orders online? And we'll fill them the next time we are filling orders. All “Immediate Fill” items can be found by searching on “BCS”.
- You don't have to use PrestoPay to order on-line.
