Dear Parents,

There are a few important topics of information that BCS would like you to pass along to you.

1. As we are forming our budget for the 2020-21 school year we are so thankful to those who have returned their registration forms for next school year. However, we are still missing a few Renewal of Registration forms. We have had an Advisory Board member make phone reminder calls – messages left – verbal confirmation of returning to BCS for the 2020-2021 school year was given. It is budget forming time and hence tuition decisions have to be made very soon. If you have not done so, please return your Renewal of Registration form soon. We look forward to having all students return to BCS for the 2020-2021 school year.

2. Also, if you haven't done so already, please complete the ONLINE FACTS Tuition Assistance application. To be eligible for any other financial assistance, you need to have COMPLETED the FACTS application online by March 16, 2020 by going to <https://diopitt.org/affordable>.

3. **Auditions for the School Play – “The Rainbow Fish Musical” - for grades 5-8 will take place on Monday, March 9, 2020 after school until 4:30 PM.** Interested students are to get an audition script from Sister John Ann and form a group for auditions including memorizing it for interpretation. Students in Kindergarten through fourth grade will be involved beginning sometime in April. The School Play is scheduled for May 7-9, 2020.

4. **This next point involves the current health concerns – The Coronavirus.** While it has **NOT** been present in our area, preventive steps are being advised. **These preventative actions will also help curtail the spread of the flu.** The following steps have been recommended by the CDC to reduce the spread of germs and avoid illness.

- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizers.
- Avoid touching eyes, mouth and nose with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with individuals who are sick.
- **Stay home when you are sick. The CDC recommends that individuals remain home for a minimum of 24 hours after you no longer have a fever.**
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then immediately discard the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect touched objects and surfaces.
- Take any anti-viral medication prescribed to you as instructed.
