

For BOTH formats – ALL STUDENTS:

- 1.) Students observing classes are still marked as **ABSENT** as they are **NOT** actively participating in the classes.
- 2.) Virtual students **MUST** be present for **ALL** classes and be **ACTIVELY ENGAGED** in the class in order to be counted as being in attendance.
- 3.) All work is to be completed and turned in **ON TIME** as designated by the teacher via Google Classroom, **NOT EMAILED OR SCANNED**.
- 4.) When students are virtual the same behavior is expected of them as if they were actually present in the classroom:
Appropriately attired (NO PAJAMAS)
NO toys or stuffed animals on work surface
No eating during class time
Seated appropriately that they can be easily seen
